Statement of Faith

Wisdom University accepts the Scriptures as the revealed Will of God, the all sufficient rule of faith and practice, and for the purpose of maintaining general unity, adopts these statements of fundamental truths and doctrine.

- **Scriptures Inspired:** The Bible is the inspired Word of God, a revelation from God to man, the complete and infallible authority for faith and conduct, and is superior to conscience and reason (2 Tim. 3:15-17; 1 Peter 1:23-25; Hebrew 4:12).
- **One True Godhead:** The triune Godhead is comprised of three separate and distinct personalities, The Father, The Son, and the Holy Spirit, who are eternally self-existent, self-revealed and function as one entity. Jesus Christ, who is God manifested in the flesh, is the second member of the Godhead, co-equal and co-eternal with the Father and The Holy Spirit.
- **Man, His Fall and Redemption:** Man was created good and upright, for God said, *“Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness.”* But, man, by voluntary transgression, fell and his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ the Son of God (Genesis 1:26-31, 3:1-7; Romans 5:12-21).
- **The Salvation of Man:**
 - (a) Man’s only hope of redemption is through the shed blood of Jesus Christ. On the cross Jesus Christ became sin and sickness providing both salvation and divine healing for all mankind, being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. For by grace we are saved through faith. *“The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart; that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved, for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.”* (Psalm 103:3; Romans 3:24; Ephesians 2:8; Romans 10:8-10)
 - (b) The Evidence of Salvation: The inward evidence to the believer of his salvation, is the direct witness of the Spirit (Romans 8:16). The outward evidence to all men is a life of righteousness and true holiness. *“And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us”* (1 John 3:23).
 - (c) Faith and Works: Salvation is by faith in Jesus Christ and not by human works, however, our works will determine the rewards in eternity (Romans 10:9-10 and 2 Cor. 5:10)
- **Baptism in Water:** The ordinance of baptism by a burial with Christ should be observed as commanded in the Scriptures by all who have really repented and in their hearts have truly believed on Christ as Savior and Lord. In so doing, they declare to the world that they have died with Jesus and that they have also been raised with Him to walk in newness of life (Matt. 28:19; Acts 10:47, 48; Romans 6:4).

Statement of Faith

- **The Lord's Supper:** *“And when He had given thanks, He broke it, and said, ‘This is my body which is broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me.’ In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.’ Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup”* (1 Cor. 11:24, 25, 28).
- **The Promise of the Father:** All believers are entitled to, and should ardently expect and earnestly seek, the promise of the Father, the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, according to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ. This was the normal experience of all in the early Christian church. With it comes the endowment of power for life and service, the bestowment of the gifts and their uses in the work of the ministry (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-8; 1 Cor. 12:1-31). This wonderful experience is distinct from and subsequent to the experience of the new birth (Acts 2:38; 10:44-45; 11:14-16; 15:7-9).
- **The Evidence of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit:** The full consummation of the Baptism of believers in the Holy Spirit is evidenced by the initial physical sign of speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance, and by the subsequent manifestation of spiritual power in public testimony and service (Acts 2:4; 10:44-46; 19:2, 6; 1:8).
- **The Church:** The church is the body of Christ, the habitation of God through the Spirit, with divine appointments for the fulfillment of her great commission.
- **Total Prosperity:**
 - (a) Spiritual: John 3:3, 11; 2 Cor. 5:17-21; Romans 10:9-10.
 - (b) Mental: 2 Tim 1:7; Romans 12:2; Isaiah 26:3.
 - (c) Physical: Isaiah 53:4, 5; Matt. 8:17; 1 Peter 2:24.
 - (d) Financial: 3 John 1:2; Malachi 3:10-11; Luke 6:38; 2 Cor. 9:6-19; Deut. 28:1-14.
 - (e) Social: Proverbs 3:4.
- **Blessed Hope:** Jesus is coming again to gather all His Saints to ever be with Him (1 Cor. 15:51-52; 1 Thess. 4:16-17; and 2 Thess. 2:1).
- **The Lake of Fire:** Those who have not accepted the redemptive work of Jesus Christ will suffer eternal separation from the Godhead. The devil and his angels, the beast and the false prophet, and anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life, shall be consigned to everlasting punishment in the lake of fire which burns with brimstone. This is the second death, the lake of fire (Rev. 19:20; 20:10-15).
- **The Millennial Reign of Jesus:** The return of our Lord Jesus Christ with His saints from Heaven to rule and reign for one thousand years on earth as the Scriptures promised. (Romans 11:25, 27; 2 Thess. 1:7; Rev. 19:11-16; 20:1-7). After this, there shall be a new heaven and a new earth (Rev. 21).

General Objectives

Spiritual Objectives:

Studies at Wisdom University should enable the student:

1. To show a profound gratitude for the sacrificial work of Christ on his/her behalf which will motivate him/her to lead a life of sincere and comprehensive obedience to the Word of God.
2. To exhibit Christian maturity and virtues identified in Scripture as the “Fruit of the Spirit” so that he/she will be able to convey Christian truth both by precept and by personal example.
3. To maintain a well ordered devotional life and a personal program of spiritual enrichment and growth.
4. To demonstrate a concern for outreach and missions by actively seeking opportunities for Christian service.
5. To manifest a consistent Christian world and life view which shows submission to the present Lordship of Christ in every area of life.

Academic Objectives:

Studies at Wisdom University should enable the student:

1. To demonstrate a general knowledge of the content and meaning of the Bible.
2. To locate and use effective tools for ministry, including the tools of independent Bible study.
3. To clearly communicate the Gospel of Jesus Christ to others in writing, private conversation, and in public address.
4. To teach others the Bible and Christian Doctrine.
5. To express the Christian view of life.
6. To demonstrate the knowledge and skills necessary for effective Christian ministry and service.
7. To pursue a self-directed program of continuing education for ministry.

1. To develop moral and ethical standards so that his/her activities and interactions with other people will be to the glory of God.
2. To develop habits consistent with mature Christian character.

4. To promote justice and mercy in social ethics, government, social change, and contemporary public affairs.

Academic Information

Graduation Requirements:

Students who have filed an application must submit a high school or GED transcript along with college transcripts. Credits at Wisdom University will not be filed officially until this is done. International students may be asked to provide additional information.

Wisdom University reserves the right to alter graduation requirements when it is decided that such changes are necessary. Normally a student may graduate according to the stated requirements at the time of admission.

Standards of Conduct:

Use of the Library

II. Hours:

The library will be open from 9 am to 5 pm, Monday-Friday.

III. Circulation:

All library materials are checked out and returned through the Admissions Office. No book, magazine, CD, video, etc. is to leave the library for any reason without first being checked out. Arrangements for proper checking out of materials should be made through the Admissions Office.

Books may be checked out for two weeks and renewed for two weeks. There will be a charge of 10 cents per day (Monday thru Sunday) for all overdue material.

Reference books DO NOT circulate.

CD's, cassette tapes, and videos may circulate for two weeks only, without benefit of renewal.

Current and back issue periodicals are NOT to be taken from the library for any reason.

If library materials are damaged beyond use or are lost, the patron will be charged the amount needed to replace the item(s).

Personal copies may be photocopied in the office for 20 cents per page. Individuals using copyrighted materials must abide by the copyright laws.

Wisdom University has received Accredited Member Status accreditation through Transworld Accrediting Association International, 9085 California Ave., Riverside, CA 92503, for the purpose of awarding degrees through the doctorate level. TAC is an independent accrediting agency that helps the religious world obtain accreditation that is not government affiliated. All TAC member schools accept credit from other member schools if the credits apply to their programs (www.transworldaccrediting.com).



This form of ministry accreditation is not recognized by the United States Department of Education, but is recognized by most churches and ministry organizations.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Wisdom University is committed to providing higher education. Our concern for academic excellence emanates from the belief that Christian higher education should be superior, not inferior, to that provided by other colleges and universities. The University feels that anything less than this is not to the glory of God. Therefore, every effort is made to provide the academic excellence worthy of a university dedicated to the Lord and necessary for the education of those preparing for service to the Lord in the days to come.

Student Policies

Standard of Conduct

A student whose personal conduct is a poor testimony for Christ, and who fails to live in accordance with the scriptural ideals of the University, will be counseled and disciplined to the extent as the Dean of Students deems advisable. The University reserves the right to refuse admission, to put on disciplinary probation, or to dismiss any student whose personal conduct and/or attitude, in the judgment of the administration, are not consistent with the spirit and standards which the University seeks to maintain.

By way of example: academic dishonesty, such as giving unauthorized aid on an examination or plagiarism (the intentional or unintentional presentation of another's work as your own), is not acceptable behavior and will not be tolerated. Both are subject to immediate dismissal.

Missed Work

The heading "Missed Work" includes, but is not limited to, quizzes, tests, exams, reports, research papers or any other class requirement by any other name/title on any specifically scheduled date.

Students are expected to take all quizzes, tests, and exams, and turn in any other work required on a specific date, if such date is assigned. If any of these items are missed, as a general rule, the missed work will be assigned 0 points when it is turned in. If the missed work is not turned in the student will receive a grade of "F" in the course.

The one exception to this general rule is an event beyond the student's control. Examples of events beyond the student's control include, but are not limited to, a medical emergency or sudden illness (supported by appropriate documentation, death of immediate family member, or business related travel. In this case, a grade letter "Inc" will be temporarily posted to the course. NOTE: In no case will an "Inc" remain on the course **for more than two weeks.**

Non-Discrimination Policy

Wisdom University does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality, ethnic origin, or gender. We guarantee the rights and privileges and the availability of all programs and activities to all students of the University.

Additional Information

The transfer of credit from Wisdom University to any other academic institution would be at the discretion of the receiving institution if they chose to accept credits from this University.

Transcripts

Official transcripts of credit will be issued by the University upon the written request of the student, provided the student's account is paid in full. See applicable Transcript Fees as stated on the Financial Information page.

Admission Policy

1. A high school diploma, GED or demonstrated equivalency is a prerequisite to enrollment in Wisdom University.
2. All Wisdom University degrees must be earned in sequential order. For example, the student must hold a Bachelor degree (or evidence of that level of education) from Wisdom University or another school with a program commensurate with that of Wisdom University levels of study in order to pursue a Masters degree in that field of study.
3. A Wisdom University application for admission (Student Application) form must be completed, signed and submitted to the University, along with any transcripts, documented studies, ministry life experience application or other documents which require evaluation for credit. All documents must be submitted in order for an Academic Review to be done and the student to be placed within an Academic Program at Wisdom University.
4. An "Affidavit of Agreement" must be read and signed and accompany the application with submission.
5. An application fee of \$50 per application (Student Application - \$50, and Ministry Life Experience Application - \$35) must accompany your application for admission.
6. All students enrolling in Wisdom University are required to subscribe to and practice a lifestyle which is an exemplary testimony for Christ and which is in accordance with the moral and spiritual standards generally accepted by the full gospel community.
7. No person will be refused admission with Wisdom University on the basis of sex, race or ethnic background.
8. Wisdom University reserves the right to reject any applicant for any reason or condition incompatible with the standards, principles or purposes of the school (or should the study be deemed impractical for the applicant).
9. If, for any reason, admission to Wisdom University is denied, any/all monies (with the exception of the non-refundable application/processing fee) will be refunded.

Financial Information – Tuition and Costs

Low Tuition Philosophy

Wisdom University believes that an exceptional, spiritual education does not have to cost a lot of money. We also believe that graduates of Wisdom University should not enter the harvest fields and their service to the Lord with oppressive financial obligations.

Therefore, we have chosen not to acquire the more expensive regional accreditation. Regional accreditation allows some students of those institutions to qualify for government-guaranteed student loans and other government programs. Institutions using these student loans generally charge the highest tuition allowable, leaving the student with considerable debt at the conclusion of their education. Therefore, Wisdom University under the auspices of Transworld Accrediting Commission International has elected a less expensive and independent accreditation.

Wisdom University has instituted a pay-as-you-go program that allows a student to work at his or her own pace and to do so affordably.

Student Payment Policy

The policy of the University is to provide flexibility to students regarding payment. The most desirable is full tuition payment at the time of registration for the course.

An advantage of the programs provided by Wisdom University is the flexibility of schedule. Students can finish their programs of study or achieve their educational goals over a period of time convenient to them. Their own personal preferences, work schedules, and their own finances determine the speed at which they progress. The student should contact the Admissions Office to discuss the payment options available.

Refund Policy

Should a student prepay fees for an entire program (one year) in advance, they may receive a refund of the unused portion upon formal withdrawal from the University. The refund is calculated on a prorated basis.

The Application Process:

1. Completely fill out the registration/application online. Please answer all questions. If an area does not apply, write DNA (does not apply) in the space. Any unanswered questions may delay the processing of your application. Please note that a one-time application fee of \$50.00 is required for each application. Please complete the payment section of the registration/application online and pay by credit or debit card. No application will be processed without the application fee. A student may also call the Admissions Office to make this payment.
2. All applicants must be at least 18 years of age or completed high school if pursuing a degree.
3. Please complete and send a Transcript Request form to each college, university or Bible institute that you have previously attended. Request they send transcripts directly to the Wisdom University Admissions Office, as all transcripts must be originals and must be mailed directly from the school to the Admissions Office.  - iv. MLE application fee of \$35.00 payable to Wisdom University.
 - v. Note: Credits will be awarded for faithfulness in ministry to a maximum of 30 credits within the Undergraduate Program and a maximum of 9 credits within the Graduate Program. Credits are not awarded within the Post-Graduate Program.

Graduation Requirements

General Requirements:

The general requirements for the conferring of diplomas and degrees are as follows:

1. Student must have completed all required course work in a chosen program prior to graduation. All students ***MUST*** have taken or transferred credits covered in the Program I subjects and complete the minimum of credit-hours in one of the University's programs.
2. Graduate student must have maintained a 3.0 or above cumulative grade point average while attending the University at the graduate level and must have paid in full all financial obligations including tuition, M.L.E. fees, graduation fee, cap and gown fee, etc. before graduation.
3. Student must have filed a fully completed "Intent to Graduate" form at least six weeks prior to graduation. (Graduation is usually scheduled for the month of September at the Wisdom Center, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Please call the Admissions Office to find out the actual date.)
4. The graduating student is expected to be in attendance at the commencement exercise.
5. All transfer credits will need a certified transcript from the institution of higher education attended sent directly to Wisdom University. No credits will be assessed for the student unless an authorized transcript is on file. *A photocopy of a student transcript will not be accepted for credit assessment.*
6. All transferable course credits must have a grade of "C" or above.

Release of Information

Privacy Right of Students

Except as required for use by the president in the discharge of his official responsibilities as prescribed by laws, regulations of the state board, and board policies, the designated custodian of such records may release information from these records to others only upon authorization in writing from the student or upon a subpoena by a court of competent jurisdiction.
